All exhibitors must have purchased a Wood County Fair membership or week pass at the time of registration, except children under 18 who may enter on a parent’s membership or with a youth exhibitor pass.

Entry Drop Off: Thursday, July 24, 5:00 - 8:00 pm

Drop off all registered entries to the Fine Arts Building on Thursday, July 24th 5:00 - 8:00 pm. Entry tags MUST be picked up at the Fair Office prior to drop off.

Judging: The Fine Arts building will be closed Friday, July 25th & Saturday, July 26th for judging.

Entry Pick Up: Monday, August 4th, 5:00 - 7:00 pm. Entries removed prior to that time forfeit all premiums and awards. The Wood County Ag Society Board of Directors or committee cannot be held responsible for articles left after 7pm on Monday, August 4th.

Entry Limit: An exhibitor may enter in only one (1) Section. Exhibitors may enter up to four (4) items per Classification. Not more than two awards shall be made in any single competition to the same exhibitor.

Eligibility:

- An exhibitor may enter in **only one (1) Section**. You must enter in your age division. The age division to enter items made by your child is the age of your child on the first day of the fair of the current year.
- No work will be accepted which has been shown previously at the Wood County Fair.
- The model department reserves the right to reclassify entries.
- Projects must have been completed within the last 12 months.

Guidelines for ALL Sections

- **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- **ALL art must be suitable for family viewing.**
- **Exhibit tickets should be folded to cover the exhibitor's name and tucked under the tab on the ticket.**

NO WORK ACCEPTED WITHOUT HAVING MET THE ABOVE CONDITIONS

At the discretion of the judges, all prizes may or may not be awarded. The decision of the judges is final. The judges are professionals in the field of art.

The Committee and Fair Board cannot be responsible for exhibits lost, damaged, or left at the fair. Exhibits will be protected as much as possible.

BEST OF SHOW ROSETTES AWARDED IN EACH SECTION

Sections A & B – All work must be securely mounted and ready to hang unless it is a three-dimensional piece. Wires must be attached securely on the back of all framed artwork. All other artwork must be matted and clips will be provided for hanging. No string, scotch tape or saw tooth hangers.

SECTION A – Professional Artists - premiums \$15, \$10, \$5 and ribbons awarded to each classification

Sections C, D, E & F – Frames allowed but not recommended. Please mount artwork on heavy matte or cardstock to avoid curling. Clips will be provided for hanging. Younger section's artwork may be hung with push pins on a cork board.

SECTION C – ages 13 to 17 years inclusive – premiums \$8, \$5, \$3 and ribbons awarded to each classification
