The Wood County Ag Society Board of Directors or committee cannot be held responsible for articles left after 7:00 pm on Monday, August 5th.

Entry Limit: 1 entry per person, per classification except in any other classes and those have a limit of 2 entries per person.

All exhibitors must have purchased a Wood County Fair membership or week pass at the time of registration, except children under 18 who may enter on a parent's membership or with a youth exhibitor pass.

RULES:

All fruit, pickles and vegetable entries must be exhibited in a standard quart or pint glass jar with new lids and rings and must have been preserved within the last year by the exhibitor.

All jams and jelly exhibits must be in standard ½ pint glass jars with new lids.

Contents must be labeled on each jar and entry tag. Please date when the exhibit was canned on jar/lid and the processing method/time used. No colored jars or jar decorations.

Only 1 entry per person in each category, except in "any other" category where two entries per person are allowed.

No oven canned goods will be accepted. All jars must be sealed. No entries will be accepted if sealed with paraffin. Preservatives of any kind must not be used. No entry will be accepted unless it can be placed in a listed category. All exhibits shall be identified with an entry tag. Use of salad or mayonnaise jar will disqualify product.

In any "any other" category, product must be labeled with content.

JUDGING STANDARDS:

Overall appearance, color, unity of size, clarity of liquid, fullness of jar, tightness of seal and quality of product. Make sure the jars are washed and the bands come off easily for judging. Cans are not opened during judging.

AWARDS:

Best of class will be awarded to the best entry in fruits, vegetables, pickles & relish, soft spreads, sauces and youth.

The exhibitor with the most points in the canning department will be awarded the Thomas Zeigler Sweepstakes award.
