Entry Release: Sunday, August 4th, 9:00 pm. Exhibits removed prior to that time forfeit all premiums and awards. Premiums may be picked up on Monday August 5th at the Fair Office.

Entry Limit: Two entries per person, per classification. Each bird requires an entry.

All exhibitors must have purchased a Wood County Fair membership or week pass at the time of registration, except children under 18 who may enter on a parent's membership or with a youth exhibitor pass.

Exhibitors are responsible for submitting entries into the proper classes.

Classes to be as follows within each classification:

## Ducks:

Class I — D (drake) male bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class II — H (hen) female bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class III — YD (young drake) male bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

Class IV — YH (young hen) female bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

## Geese:

Class I — G (gander) male bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class II — GO (goose) female bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class III — YG (young gander) male bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

Class IV — YGO (young goose) female bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

Any specimen showing symptoms of disease will be refused or taken from exhibit and isolated, if possible.

Health requirements are found at the front of the fair book.

All exhibits entered at owner's risk.

Owners must furnish feed and make provisions for care of exhibits which include non spillable water containers and dry bedding.

Coops will be furnished for waterfowl, coops must be cleaned out at end of fair.

Show will be classified.

American Standard of Perfection and comparison method of judging will be used.

Need not be present for judging. Judging will take place at cage where birds are displayed.
