 Any animal shown out of class will be disqualified for that class only.
 Dry cows may NOT be shown in classes 9 through 16.
 Only two entries per class for each exhibitor's pass.

- 9. Injecting material into udders or teats for non-medical purposes or otherwise artificially modifying the appearance or conformation of the udder or teat is NOT allowed.
