Premium: All bands will be paid \$200, payable to booster clubs only

Class III—4-H Club/Youth Organization (Non-Float)

Uniformed groups of 12 or more riding on a wagon or truck

Rules & Regulations:

- 1. Parade will leave the staging area at 7:00 p.m. and travel through the fairgrounds.
- 2. First place will be awarded to participants in Classes I.
- 3. Floats must be the work of the organization entering the parade and be no smaller than 6'x10' and no semi-trailers.
- 4. No animals allowed in the parade.
- 5. Floats will enter grounds at North Brim Road (Gate E) and proceed north of campers to the gate west of Horse Barns if they are being assembled in the camp grounds. Floats can enter through gate A if they are assembled before arrival. Line up for judging on the racetrack.

candy should be thrown while parading.

- * * No Advertising or Political Signs in the parade.
- 6. A Senior Fair Director will be at the entrance of the track to help direct you to your position. Numbers will be posted on the track fence.
- 7. Floats should be in the designated judging area on Sunday, July 27th by 4:30pm. Judging will begin at 5p.m. Those not ready will be penalized. **The driver, advisors and only club members** to be interviewed should be in the judging area after 5 p.m.
- 8. Floats will be judged according to the following scorecard:

Organization identification (Large enough to see well)	15	points	
Interview (brief interview of club members chosen at random by judges)	10	points	
Posterboard of float construction (standard size)	5	points	
Appearance (attractive, originality, general idea, theme, neatness)	40	points	
Eye catching (your first impression)	20	points	
Art Principle (line, proportion, balance)	10	points
